



Thank you for your interest in the Car Care Council Women's Board (WB). The WB is comprised of professional women and men, including motor sports figures, service shop owners, technicians, service writers, association and company executives and consultants,

who are dedicated to informing female audiences about proper vehicle maintenance and safety, while encouraging young people to investigate automotive career choices. The WB and its parent group, the Car Care Council, merged with the Automotive Aftermarket Industry Association (AAIA). AAIA is the home of the "Be Car Care Aware" consumer education campaign. The board works closely with AAIA and acts as an advisory board to the "Be Car Care Aware" message, which dovetails with the WB goals.

Other areas in which the board is active include:

Women's Car Care Clinics

Board members participate in and support community car care clinics, especially those geared toward women.

The Automotive Communications Awards (ACA)

This awards reception, held during AAPEX in Las Vegas, rewards companies/agencies who provide automotive information through outstanding advertising, marketing and PR efforts.

Women's Board scholarships

The Women's Board awards annual scholarships to female students studying to enter the aftermarket. Scholarships are presented during the Women's Board reception during AAPEX.

Distribution of information

The board uses conventional media, industry trade shows and high school counselor conferences to spread the message to women about car care and automotive careers. The board distributes a bimonthly newsletter titled *Women on Board*, full of information about women in the industry.

Affiliation with women's programs

The WB encourages businesses to work with girls'/women's groups to foster interest in automotive maintenance and careers.

Girl Scout Badges

An automotive badge workshop has been developed for Girl Scouts to learn the importance of vehicle maintenance and safety.
